



Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) and Adoption of Existing Environmental Documents

Description of proposal:

An ordinance for electric vehicle charging stations which would amend the city's municipal code to 1) Add definitions for the various aspects of the electric vehicle infrastructure, 2) Amend the Permitted Uses Tables in SMC 21A.20 and 21 B to make allowances for the installation of charging stations and battery exchange stations as a primary or accessory use, 3) Modify the parking standards to indicate the number of parking stalls that need to be provided in parking lot or parking garage, 4) Restrict general parking in designated electric charging parking spaces

Proponent: City of Sammamish, Department of Community Development

Location of proposal: The Municipal Code is applicable within the corporate boundaries of the City.

Lead agency: City of Sammamish, Department of Community Development

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. Descriptions: These documents describe, on a programmatic level, the natural and built environmental features, functions, and values located in the City of Sammamish, and the impacts associated with the adoption of the Sammamish Comprehensive Plan.

An Environmental Checklist for a non-project action was prepared under the State Environmental Policy Act (RCW Chapter 43.21.C), pursuant to WAC Chapter 197-11 and the City of Sammamish Municipal Code Chapter 20.15 and a notice of adoption and determination of non-significance (DNS) was issued on December 9, 2010 with a comment period ending on December 23, 2010.
