Notice of Application for a Wireless Communication Facility / SEPA Notification

Sahalee Way WCF - PLN2010-00005

Project Description: Clearwire proposes to attach three panel antennas, three microwave dishes and three PRU units mounted to a proposed 99'-5" AGL PSE replacement wood pole. The existing PSE pole of 59.4' in height would be replaced with a pole 40 feet taller. Clearwire proposes to attach a site support cabinet to base of the proposed replacement pole.

The applicant (Steven Topp, Clearwire) applied for the above project on February 02, 2010; following a review to confirm that a complete application had been received, the City issued a letter of completion to the applicant on February 25, 2010. On March 11, 2010, the City issued this Notice of Application / SEPA Notification by the following means: mailed notice to property owners within 500 feet of the subject site, a sign posted on the subject site, and by placing a legal notice in the local newspaper.
