

Expected duties of camper

Security shifts

At least two security shifts must be done per week; it may be more depending on the amount of campers.

These shifts are three hours long, and you must be capable of doing them.

Various duties are expected to be performed and whatever the Camp Supervisor on duty tells you to do.

If you miss a shift, it may result in you being evicted.

Period starts on Monday at 12:01am, and runs until Sunday at 11:59pm.

Blankets

Blankets are not provided to you by CUE. However, it is quite common for there to be blankets as gifts from our donors. If you need blankets, you may be given some from donations, and they become your personal property and responsibility.

Things you might get evicted for

Loitering in the neighborhood.

Anything that causes a preventable 911 call.

Theft of any kind.

Consuming alcohol within two miles of the host church.

Arguing with Camp Supervisor or Executive Officer.

Parking your car on host church property when you do not have permission to do so.

Repeated write-ups.

Sexual harassment of another camper.

Accumulating human waste in your Tent. We pay a lot of money every month for portable toilets.

Any eviction with a duration longer than required for a site bar, must be appealed before the Board of Directors.
