



**NOTICE OF APPLICATION / SEPA NOTIFICATION
SHORELINE EXEMPTION - SDT2016-00012**

Project Description: Replace existing floating pier with a fixed pier. The fixed pier will consist of 6 4-inch steel pipes and 254 square feet of Thru-Flow grated decking. The total overwater coverage will be reduced by 56 square feet.

On January 13, 2016 an application was submitted by ASHLEY SHORELINE DESIGN and deemed complete on February 08, 2016. On February 12, 2016, the City issued this Notice of Application/SEPA by the following means: mailed notice to property owners within 500 feet of the subject site, a sign posted on the subject site, and by placing a legal notice in the local newspaper.
