

Notice of Intent - Construction Stormwater General Permit

City of Sammamish, Tawni Dalziel, 801 228th Ave SE Sammamish, WA 98075, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit.

The proposed project, Inglewood Hill Stormwater Retrofit and Non-motorized Improvement Project, is located on NE Inglewood Hill Road from the intersection with East Lake Sammamish Parkway to the west and 212th Ave NE to the east. Construction will occur along 208th Ave NE, NE 15th St, 210th Ave NE, 211th Ave NE and 211th PI NE extending north from NE Inglewood Hill Road in Sammamish in King County.

This project involves 1.61 acres of soil disturbance for Highway or Road, Utilities construction activities.

The receiving waterbody is Lake Sammamish.

Any persons desiring to present their views to the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding this application, or interested in Ecology's action on this application, may notify Ecology in writing no later than 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II antidegradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
