Proposed amendments to the City of Sammamish's Comprehensive Plan and
Development Code

Public Hearing Dates: July 10 & 17, 2018

Notice is hereby given that the City of Sammamish City Council will hold two public hearings regarding proposed amendments to the City's Glossary and Transportation Element of the 2015 Sammamish Comprehensive Plan and associated code amendments to Titles 14, 14A, 20, 21A, 21B, and 27A of the Sammamish Municipal Code (SMC).

SUMMARY of AMENDMENTS: The City Council is considering amendments to concurrency and level of service (LOS) policies as well as technical background information in the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan. The proposed amendments directly address a City Council-identified emergency regarding the City's transportation LOS and concurrency.

The City Council is also considering amendments to the City of Sammamish's transportation concurrency and level of service (LOS) regulations (Titles 14, 14A, 20, 21A, 21B, and 27A SMC). The proposed amendments include regulations for concurrency and LOS, as well as non-substantive and reference updates to other parts of the SMC for consistency.

HEARING SCHEDULE: Public testimony will be taken by the City Council on July 10, 2018 regarding the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan, and on July 17, 2018 regarding the associated code amendments. The public hearing on July 10, 2018 will be part of a special public meeting and the public hearing on July 17, 2018 will be part of a regular public meeting, which will both start at 6:30 PM at the City of Sammamish City Hall, located at 801 228th Avenue SE, Sammamish.
