

RFP QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

1. Has the Overall Drainage Basin Study listed on the City of Sammamish's CIP project list been done or being done? When and by who?
Zackuse Basin Plan has not begun.
2. Does the proposed project include grant funds? If so, from who?
The project includes \$157,400 grant from King County Water Works Program. We have also applied for a KC Flood Reduction Grant and the Snoqualmie Tribe plans to submit an application to the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Tribal Wildlife Grant Program.
3. How involved is the private property owner, Dr. Pereyra, going to be during the project? Is the city acquiring an easement from him?
He is on our stakeholder committee for the project and he will provide comments to the City PM on design. He has granted a Right of Entry for the project and the City will be responsible for acquiring all easements and other necessary permissions from him for construction and monitoring. He has indicated his strong desire to make the project successful.
