Re: Draft ECA language

Evan,

After reviewing the most current draft of the proposed new ECA language, specifically that which deals with the EHNSWB Pilot Program, it appears that you have made several changes that I think you should reconsider:

- In section **e (iv)**, you have eliminated the paragraph that allows extension of the construction season with permission from the director. We believe that this is a mistake; if weather permits, allowing additional work to proceed can actually better prepare a site for wet weather.
- In section **(iv) A**, the sentence describing the design storm events is confusing, I suggest the following:

(A) Temporary water quality treatment facilities shall be sized to treat runoff generated by cleared areas during the -10 year storm event during May through September and the 25 year storm event for the remainder of the year and release treated runoff with a measured turbidity of no more than 25 NTU.

Also, you should double check the section / outline numbering and lettering, it seems incorrect- there are two section (iv)'s in a row.
