**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH, WASHINGTON,
RECOGNIZING THE EFFORTS OF CONGRESSMAN DAVE
REICHERT IN SECURING FUNDING FOR THE EAST LAKE
SAMMAMISH PARKWAY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, East Lake Sammamish Parkway is one of the primary transportation facilities within the City of Sammamish, Washington; and

WHEREAS, rapid growth and increased usage to the parkway have required it to be improved and expanded; and

WHEREAS, the improvements to East Lake Sammamish Parkway will require a large investment from the City's Capital Facility Program and will provide the significant benefits of increasing safety, non-motorized mobility, traffic flow and enhancing economic development; and

WHEREAS, partnership between different jurisdictions is needed to fund such large transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Dave Reichert worked diligently from his seat on the US House of Representatives – Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure - to secure \$750,000 in funding for this project by the passage of H.R. 3058; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Dave Reichert was able to keep these funds in the version of the bill that passed the full House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sammamish is looking forward to working with Congressman Dave Reichert in ensuring that these funds remain in the final version of the bill;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Sammamish expresses its deep appreciation to Congressman Reichert and his staff for their diligent effort on behalf of all the constituents in the region who will benefit from the improvement of East Lake Sammamish Parkway– and look forward to continuing to work together to make further improvements in the region.
