**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH A GRANT
APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH A WASHINGTON
WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM PROJECT TO THE
INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION FOR THE
ACQUISITION OF HABITAT CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR
RECREATION LANDS KNOWN AS THE BEAVER LAKE PRESERVE PHASE
II**

WHEREAS, the City of Sammamish has been notified by the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) that the City is eligible to receive grant money, on a matching basis, for land acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considers it to be in the public interest to apply for such grant funds under the provisions of the Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program, which provides state funds to assist in the financing of land acquisition and/or facility development; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized application to the IAC for funding assistance for this project in 2002 but was unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, since the date of the original application, the size of the parcel proposed for purchase, the amount of funding assistance requested, and the amount of financial commitment required from the City have been revised; and

WHEREAS, the City Council provided an appropriate opportunity for public comment on the proposed application on December 5, 2006 at a regular City Council meeting.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAMMAMISH, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to proceed with an application to the IAC for funding assistance for the acquisition of the Beaver Lake Preserve Phase II.

Section 2. Any funding assistance received shall be used solely for implementation of said project.

Section 3. In the event that sufficient state funding is secured, the City hereby certifies that its local match share of project funding is committed and will be derived from funds received from King County and from dedicated City funds in the parks capital budget.

Section 4. The City acknowledges that any property acquired or facility developed with the IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City and IAC.

Section 5. This resolution shall become a part of the application to the IAC.
