Public Works Updates for August 16 - 23

Patching on Issaquah-Fall City Road

On Tuesday, August 20, and possibly Wednesday, August 21, we will be doing patching on Issaquah-Fall City Road, between Klahanie Dr SE and Issaquah Beaver Lake Road.

Lane closures will happen between 9:30am and 3:30pm.

The contractor is optimistic it will only take one working day to do all of the work.

Message boards were posted on both sides of the project zone on August 12.

Pavement Repairs at Audubon Park

On Wednesday, August 21, or Thursday, August 22, (depending on the above work) pavement repairs will happen at the entrance of Audubon Park, between SE 24th St and SE 25th Pl.

The entrance is expected to be completely inaccessible later in the morning due to the center island on the roadway.

A detour will be set up to have drivers enter and exit Audubon Park through 233rd Ave SE and 234th Pl SE.

We have requested northbound traffic be able to exit during the morning commute, before the contractor jumps to the other direction.

This work will only take one day. Message boards for this work were posted on August 14.

Lane Closure on 228th on Saturday, August 17

There will be a short duration lane closure on 228th Ave SB near the SE 4th St. intersection beginning at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 17. Centurylink needs to access a maintenance hole to connect the fiber optic system conversion on SE 4th St to the existing system. The lane will be reopened by 3:30 p.m.

4th Street to get Curbs and Gutters

The good news: Contractors will begin placing new curb and gutter on the south side of SE 4th St.! This work is anticipated to start as early as Wednesday, August 21 but, as always, could change depending on weather and other construction scheduling issues.

The bad news: The process to set curb and gutter is intensive and involves a significant amount of construction workers and equipment. This often results in additional lengthy traffic delays. Travelers should consider taking alternate routes – SE 20th St to the south and Inglewood Hill Rd to the north.

Issaquah Fall City Road Phase 1

The long-awaited first phase of construction of the Issaquah-Fall City Road project will begin on August 26. The contractor will begin mobilizing their equipment and work trailers for the project.

2019 Asphalt Overlay Project

Following the newly completed concrete sidewalk and ADA ramp replacement, the asphalt contractor will begin the roadway repairs. The contractor has already milled the portion of SE 24th to be repaired this year, and will be following with asphalt next week. In addition, the contractor will be working in the following neighborhoods: Pike Lake Meadows and Rainbow Lake Ranch.

PSE Gas

PSE has completed the patching in the NE 25th Way area. We are awaiting confirmation of the final overlay of the roadway.

Verizon 5G

The work crews have completed the underground fiberoptic conduit along 228th at the intersection with Inglewood Hill Road. The contractor is expected to return to replace the damaged concrete sidewalk panels that have temporary patches. There will be intermittent barricaded and coned-off zones when those repairs occur.
